DESCRIPTION OF WORK: Contractor is to furnish and install all labor and materials associated with the complete installation of a new HVAC system. The existing HVAC unit is to be removed and a new contractor provided unit installed per the construction documents. Contractor is to be aware that this work will require construction barricades and pedestrian re-routes. Construction area is very heavily populated with students and staff, requiring contractor to stage and coordinate all work as to not impact the flow of pedestrian traffic.

Estimated Construction Cost: \$100,000.00
