Provide construction of seven new laboratory procedure rooms approximately 1493 SF, including corridors, on the 3rd and 4th floors at Biological Sciences, building 571.

Provide metal stud wall construction, doors and access control hardware with acoustic ceilings. Assemble and commission research cold room including specialized floors walls and ceiling. Support with mechanical equipment designed by cold room manufacture to meet crucial temperature control with compressor equipment located within basement. Electrical shall require fire mass notification speakers, lighting, communications, equipment grounding, access control and 120/208 volt wire mold and connected receptacles. Connect existing mechanical duct and route insulated duct to new variable air volume boxes fitted with controls and hot water coils. Balance all air and hot water systems during commissioning process. Support new labs with variable frequency drive exhaust fans, using in part existing duct work. Provide new duct distribution within 12x12 building shaft from roof to new spaces linking to building management system.
