**Description of Work:** Provide all labor, materials, equipment, tools, transportation, insurance, for the construction of an HVAC system upgrade, including but not limited to: HVAC equipment, selective demolition, new air handling unit and associated ductwork, new hot water boiler, and TAB and commissioning services, as described in the Construction Documents. Existing Johnson Controls POC shall remain in place.

**General Project Information:** The successful Bidder and its Subcontractors will be required to follow the nondiscrimination requirements set forth in the Bidding Documents and to pay prevailing wage rates at the location of the Work. The successful Bidder will be required to have the following California current and active contractor's license at the time of submission of the Bid:
