Subject to conditions prescribed by the University of California, Santa Barbara, sealed bids for a Lump Sum Contract are invited for the following Work:

## **DESCRIPTION OF WORK:**

Provide all labor, materials, equipment, tools, transportation, insurance, and services to construct a 1,730 gross square foot, specialized laboratory within an occupied 1967 Biological Sciences II building, including but not limited to constructing interior improvements within the second floor. Improvements shall include the construction of a main lab, microscopy/optics room, behavior #1 (optical/light), temperature behavior room #2, research offices, equipment room and improvements to the adjacent building corridor and procedure room.

The work includes all mechanical electrical and plumbing connections within the existing shaft building infrastructure, and replacement and modification of building life safety mass notification and fire sprinklers within the approved space. Temperature control, HVAC infrastructure and sequencing shall be the focal point of the performance verification of the laboratory environment.

Estimated Construction Cost: \$900,000

Bidding Documents will be available to Bidders on <u>March 13, 2017</u> and will be issued via the University's online planroom at <a href="http://ucsbplanroom.com/">http://ucsbplanroom.com/</a>. Only bidders who participate in both the Pre-Bid Conference and the Job Walk in their entirety, will be allowed to bid the Project as prime contractors.

Please note: Bidders are advised that there may be traffic congestion and parking may be difficult. Bidders should allow ample time to drive to the above location in heavy traffic, find a parking space, walk to the building, and arrive in the designated Meeting Room prior to the required time. Any prospective Bidder arriving after the above designated starting time may be disqualified from submitting a bid for this project.

**Minimum Bidder Qualifications:** To be eligible for consideration for award, a bidder must satisfy the minimum qualification requirements set forth in the Supplementary Instructions to Bidders included in the Construction Documents. Bidders must submit the University-provided Qualification Questionnaire as an attachment to its Bid Form.

Qualification Procedure(s): The Qualification Questionnaire will be available as part of the Construction Documents Documents on the date above. The evaluation is solely for the purpose of determining bidders who are deemed qualified for successful performance of the type of work included in this project. The contract will be awarded to the *qualified* Bidder submitting the lowest responsive bid. University of California reserves the right to reject any or all responses to Qualification Questionnaires and any or all bids and to waive non-material irregularities in any Qualification Questionnaire response or bid received. All information submitted for qualification evaluation will be considered official information acquired in confidence, and the University will maintain its confidentiality to the extent permitted by law.
