Subject to conditions prescribed by the University of California, Santa Barbara, sealed bids for a Lump Sum Contract are invited for the following Work:

**Project Name:** NCOS Visitor Plaza

**Summary of Work:** Construction of new visitor amenities which include decomposed granite Visitor's Plaza with stone benches and shade structure (shade sails base bid, steel structure alternate bid item), interpretive signs, site map, display case, decomposed granite trail from existing sidewalk at Whittier Drive to Visitor's Plaza (alternate bid item from Whittier to first bridge), water quality swales at parking lot leading through Discovery Garden (base bid) and swale from parking lot around Cart Barn (alternate bid item), enclosure for portable ADA-compliant portable restroom, bike parking, Discovery Garden with ethnobotanical educational focus, grinding rocks, interpretive displays, and bridges over swales, five overlooks at trails with discovery garden areas, benches, and small location or dedication signs, four (4) trailhead signs. The bid solicitation includes three separate Bid Alternates.
