The following changes, additions or deletions shall be made to the following document(s) as indicated; all other conditions shall remain the same.

Change Demolition/Construction Notes, No. 6 to read: "Coordinate proposed contractor staging area with the University Representative prior to construction. Provide temporary phone, toilet(s), fencing, gates, etc. as required. Remove a portion of the existing steel fence, as required to access the site for large equipment. University Representative to approve prior to removal. Fence to be re-installed, welded and painted, as required"

2. Dwg. DP-1 – Existing Pool ‘A’/Pool ‘B’ Demolition Plan

Add Demolition/Construction Notes No. 22: "Contractor shall remove all swimming pool deck equipment including (but not limited to), hand rails, grab rails, ladders, disabled access lift, disabled access ramp guard railing systems, and movable bulkhead prior to start of pool deck demolition. Contractor responsible to crane bulkhead out of pool for construction and re-install. All swimming pool deck equipment shall be stored on site and protected from the elements by Contractor until re-installed. Contractor shall carefully protect all swimming pool deck equipment anchors, removing and replacing (in their proper position and elevation) any and all anchors sustaining damage during the swimming pool deck demolition process. Upon completion of construction of replacement swimming pool decks, Contractor shall thoroughly clean and polish all swimming pool deck equipment to the satisfaction of University's Representative, and re-install same. Contractor shall furnish and install new escutcheon plates (316 Stainless Steel Spectrum #35214, or equal) for all swimming pool deck equipment requiring same."
