DESCRIPTION OF WORK:

Demolition of an existing parking lot and construction of a complex of three buildings including all related site utilities, hardscape, irrigation and landscaping for:

(1) Gevirtz Graduate School of Education; a 4-story building of approximately 97,300 GSF of classrooms, faculty offices, meeting rooms and related staff support spaces.

(2) College of Letters and Science; a 4-story building of approximately 96,700 GSF of classrooms, faculty offices, meeting rooms, film screening rooms and related staff support spaces.

(3) Center for Film, Television and New Media (CFTVNM), a 2 story, approximately 15,570 GSF theater building with 298 seats.

Type IV, sprinklered buildings. Steel eccentrically braced frames and special moment resisting frames with structural steel framing at the two 4-story buildings. Cast-in-place concrete shear walls, and ordinary steel braced frames at (CFTVNM).

Estimated Construction Cost: \$76,000,000.00

Bid Security in the amount of 10% of the Lump Sum Base Bid shall accompany each Bid. The Surety issuing the Bid Bond shall be, on the Bid Deadline, an admitted surety insurer (as defined in California Code of Civil Procedures Section 995.120).

The successful Bidder and its Subcontractors will be required to follow the nondiscrimination requirements set forth in the Bidding Documents and to pay prevailing wage rates at the location of the Work. A copy of the general prevailing per diem wage rates will be on file at University's principal Facilities office and will be made available to any interested party upon request. For this project, the University has initiated and shall enforce a labor compliance program ("LCP") in conformance with Labor Code sections 1771.5(b) and 1771.7. A pre-construction conference will be held with the successful Bidder and its Subcontractors to discuss federal and state labor law requirements to this project.
