The mandatory Level 2 site visit and firm interviews will tentatively take place on the UCSB campus in late October. A request for supplementary prequalification materials from each firm, including a preliminary staffing proposal, and the University's provision of additional details regarding the interview and mandatory site visit will be forwarded to each Level 1 prequalified firm under separate cover.
