



**REQUEST FOR BIDS
(Job Order Contract)**

Subject to conditions prescribed by the University of California, Santa Barbara, sealed bids for a Job Order Contract (“JOC”) are invited for the following work:

Project Name: Job Order Contract- Hazardous Material Removal and Demolition

Project Number: FM230017-JOC

Description of Work: Perform friable asbestos abatement, non-friable asbestos abatement, lead-related construction tasks, clean demolition of building components and general demolition of building components. Contractor will be performing work in both occupied and un-occupied buildings. The awarded JOC will generally be used to support larger construction projects that have a total estimated cost of work equal to or in excess of \$50,000 and/or have an asbestos containing material, Pb containing material and/or water damaged material removal component as part of the overall construction of the work (“Hazardous Work”). The maximum Job Order Contract amount for all Job Orders during the course of the initial one-year contract term is \$220,000 with two separate one-year options, if exercised, for \$200,000 each. Note, the annual Job Order Contract amounts are not cumulative.

MINIMUM BIDDER QUALIFICATIONS: All bidders must have the minimum experience set forth in the Bidding Documents, including the minimum criteria set forth in the UCSB Qualification Questionnaire as an attachment to the Bid Form. The University’s evaluation is solely for the purpose of determining which bidders are deemed qualified for to successfully perform the type of work included as part of this project. The contract will be awarded to the qualified bidder submitting the lowest responsive bid.

The University reserves the right to reject any or all responses to Qualification Questionnaires and any or all bids and to waive non- material irregularities in any response or bid received. All information submitted for qualification evaluation will be considered official information acquired in confidence and the University will maintain its confidentiality to the extent permitted by law.

Construction Documents: Construction Documents will be made available on August 30, 2022, and will be issued via the University's online planroom at www.ucsbplanroom.com. Once registered on the UCSB planroom website, prospective bidders may view and/or download the Construction Documents for free. To access those documents, simply go the University plan room site, click "Private Jobs" under the Menu bar on the left side of the web page, and enter the Job Key "**hazmat**" (all lower case, no quotes). If possible, the posted documents should be evaluated by the participants prior to the scheduled pre-bid meeting. It is the sole responsibility of prime contractors to register at <http://ucsbplanroom.com/> in order to be able to receive and view project updates, notifications, addenda, and full versions of the construction documents.

Only bidders who participate in the initial (virtual or in-person) pre-bid conference, will be allowed to bid on the Project as a prime bidder. Only attendees as the original pre-bid conference will be permitted to schedule a subsequent site visit with the University Representative.

Please note: As part of the University's efforts to ensure the health and safety of meeting participants, attendees must complete an online COVID survey using the [QR code](#) (see below) provided by University staff. The QR code must be scanned with each attendee's smart phone and the survey completed prior to attending any on-site pre-bid meeting. Each attendee must 'pass' the COVID symptom survey BEFORE entering the meeting room. A contractor who is on time for the in- person meeting, but either: (a) declines to take; or (b) fails the online survey is free to attend the pre-bid conference via Zoom on their smart phone if the pre-bid is simulcast, but may have to make arrangements with the University Representative to attend a separate Job Walk, if any.



Bid Deadline: Sealed bids must be received on or before 2:30 PM on **September 27, 2022.**

Bid Security: Bid Security in the amount of \$50,000 shall accompany each Bid. The surety issuing the Bid Bond shall be, on the Bid Deadline date, an admitted surety insurer (as defined in California Code of Civil Procedure Section 995.120).
